


JAMAICA'S MANUFACTURING SECTOR



The Jamaican manufacturing sector encompasses over 300 companies involved in a variety of manufacturing activities. Global and local leading brands are manufactured in Jamaica, by Jamaicans.

The sector consists of traditional and non-traditional categories with goods that include coffee, rum, tobacco, sugar, citrus products and cocoa products being considered traditional, and others including chemicals, processed food & beverage, furniture, building products, petroleum products, electronics, cosmetics, pharmaceuticals and apparel being seen as non-traditional.

In recent years manufacturing has achieved between 8 and 9% of GDP, making the sector a significant contributor to the economy.

The Manufacturing sector in Jamaica is diverse, and so are the opportunities.

- Agro-processing Production of value-added food products such as beverages, fruit jams, liqueurs, sauces and spices.
- Medical devices Production of medical disposables, PPE and medical equipment.
- Non-equity modes (NEMs) Jamaica is ideal for contract manufacturing and private labelling.
- Pharmaceuticals Jamaica is the largest producer of over the counter (OTC) pharmaceuticals in the Caribbean, and is an ideal location for expansion of pharma production.
- Paper products Jamaica has the capability for environmentally friendly manufacture of paper products from the abundance of locally grown bamboo and other bio-degradable material.





- **Cosmetics -** Jamaica boasts rich resources of many of the top plant-based natural ingredients used to manufacture hair, skin, and other natural cosmetics products. Jamaica is the home of the world-famous Jamaican Black Castor Oil.
- Medical Cannabis and Hemp Jamaica is one of the first countries to establish a regulatory regime and licensing agency to facilitate the medical cannabis industry. Currently there are over 80 Cannabis licences issued in Jamaica.
- Furniture & Building Materials From hotels, to commercial, to residential projects, the booming construction sector offers tremendous opportunities for the building materials, building systems, and furniture industries.
- Production of industrial and household chemicals
- lubricants, cleaning products, disinfectants, bleach and raw chemicals for manufacturing are just a few of the opportunities.

- The need has arisen for supply chain reorganization to bring manufacturing of products closer to customers.

- New wellness therapies associated with cannabis and products manufactured from tropical plants which grow abundantly in Jamaica. The global cannabidiol market size was is expected to expand at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 21.2% from 2021 to 2028.
